Action taken on Agenda Items

1. The Johnson County Board of Education met in a work/call session at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4, 2013. The chairman, Mr. Buckles called the meeting to order. Four Board Members were present: Mr. Buckles, Mr. Carlton, Mr. Dunn and Mr. Long. Tina Lipford, recorder.

Following an explanation by Mr. Woodring the work session became a formal meeting and a motion was made by Mr. Long, seconded by Mr. Carlton and carried by unanimous roll call vote to approve the 2013-2014 school budget to include all budgets: General Purpose School Fund, Federal Projects, Central Cafeteria, and Head Start. This includes the approval of the presented proposed budgetary cuts and authorizes Mr. Woodring and Mr. Robinson to adjust local revenue estimates, add reserves, fund balance and the final BEP allocation when they become available.
A motion was made by Mr. Carlton and seconded by Mr. Dunn that the meeting adjourn. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
